Class Website:

Check it out to see what we are up to in Careers, when assignments are due, tests are scheduled and to print out assignments that may have gotten lost or left behind.

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Chromebooks:

We will be using the Chromebooks in class. They will need to be brought to class every day and will need to be charged. Your Chromebooks **MUST** be in their case when not in use!

Cell Phone:

Students may not use cell phones during class periods unless teacher permission is granted to use the device for educational purposes. When you enter the class, phones are to be placed into the cell phone pockets.

Mastery Work:

Mastery work accounts for 80% of your grade. Mastery work are assignments that show what you have learned. This will include most projects, tests and quizzes.

Practice Work:

To prepare for tests, there will be practice work given. Practice work will count for 20% of your grade. No practice work will be accepted after the test day for that unit. Work done in anything other than pen or pencil (crayon/markers) will not be accepted.

Late Work:

If an assignment is turned in one day late it will be reduced by 50%. If an assignment is two days late or more it will receive a zero. You will receive one "whoops" pass each quarter to use on a late assignment to receive full credit as long as the assignment is turned in within the current unit.

Absences:

Students will be given one day for every day absent to make up work. If a student is gone for more than one day, they will be given the equal number of days to complete the make-up work. If a student was told about a test or project that was due before they were gone, the teacher may require they take the test or turn in the assignment on the day they return.

Students missing school due to school activities are expected to pick up their work prior to the activity.

Cheating:

Whether you give or receive information during an exam or on an assignment, the offense is the same. You will receive a "0" on the work.

Professionalism Grade:

Every student will be given 2 pts. per day of class that the student shows up on time and is prepared. If students are tardy they will lose 1 point. If students are not prepared for class with their materials they will also lose 1 point. If a student is absent they will lose both points for the day **BUT** if they turn in the work that was done on the day of their absence they will earn those 2 points back.
